The Colorado Governor's Residence began as a landmark private home, was transformed into a display of old-world elegance and remains one of the west's true treasure houses as it approaches its second century. Built in 1907 by the Cheesman family, this landmark mansion atop Logan's Hill soars three stories.

The Denver Art Museum is a 356,000-square-foot museum complex that includes collection gallery space, three temporary exhibition venues, and the Lewis I. Sharp Auditorium. Designed by world-renowned Michael Graves and the Denver firm of Klipp Colussy Jenks DuBois, the 540,000 square-foot Central Library opened in 1995. The tour will cover the main art and architecture highlights of The Central.
