PUBLICATION TIMELINE

PHASE 1: SUBMISSION AND REVIEW	
PROCEDURES	APPROX. TIME
JID office receives and acknowledges submission from author	1 week
Editor in Chief assigns reviewers to the manuscript; Reviewers complete triple-blind review	6-10 weeks
Editor in Chief analyzes reviews, notifies author of review outcome	5-12 weeks
TOTAL	3-6 months

The Submission and Review process (Phase 1) takes approximately 3-6 months. Because of the range of possible review outcomes, the average time elapsing after this phase is difficult to estimate. The table below outlines the various Review Outcomes (Phase 2) and suggests a general timeline from Revisions to Acceptance.

PHASE 2: REVISIONS	
REVIEW OUTCOMES	PROCEDURES
"Publishable as is" (rarely, if ever, happens)	Manuscript is immediately accepted for next available issue.
"Publishable pending minor revisions"	Author is given suggested deadline for revisions (May 1 for Fall issue, Sept. 1 for Spring issue). Once revisions are submitted, Editor determines whether manuscript is acceptable for publication; if yes, manuscript is slated for next available issue.
"Revise and resubmit for 2 nd review"	Author is encouraged to resubmit revised manuscript; submission and review process starts again from the beginning.
"Reject as unacceptable"	Manuscript is deemed unacceptable for publication; no further reviews or revisions are considered.

PHASE 3: PUBLICATION

Two hard-copy issues are published annually, the first in the fall (e.g. Vol.31, No.1) and the second in the spring (e.g. Vol.31, No. 2). Special editions on current issues or themes are occasionally published (in hard copy and/or electronic form) in the summer (e.g. Vol.31, No.3).

Due to space limitations and a rolling submission/acceptance policy, the amount of time that elapses between a manuscript's date of acceptance and actual publication varies substantially. On average, manuscripts are currently being published approximately one year from the **date of acceptance**.
